

# YOATZIM (PARENT LIAISONS) 2024

Yoatzim (parent liaisons/advisors) comprise camper care team, overseen by our Camp Director, Rachael Abrams, LCSW-C. During the summer, the Yoetz/et is your primary contact person to ask questions and discuss any concerns regarding your child.

To speak to your child's Yoetz/et, please call 570.798.2504. Yoatzim spend much of their days working directly with campers and counselors. Aside from emergencies, please allow 24-36 hours for returned calls. The Yoetz/et will contact families of all first time campers during the first few days of camp to report on their child's adjustment. Please note: unless it is an emergency, campers do not speak to their parents on the phone.

If you need to contact camp regarding a necessary item (please review our [package policy here](#)) that your child forgot/needs replacing, email your child's Yoetz/et. Phone calls should ALWAYS be used to address camper concerns and behaviors. The most timely way to reach your child's Yoetz/et is by calling camp. (These email addresses are only accessed during the camp season and Taste of Ramah is only accessed the weekend before and through Taste of Ramah. Please be in touch with Rachael Abrams with camper care concerns prior to the first day of camp.) More information can be found in our [handbook](#).
